- (a) Explain why the Younger Pitt adopted a policy of repression after 1792. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the challenge of radicalism the most important development in politics and government in the period 1780-1832? [36]

2. Economic and social change and popular protest, c.1815-1848

- (a) Explain why the Poor Law Amendment Act of 1834 was passed. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Anti-Corn Law League the most important influence on economic and social change and popular protest in the period 1815-1848? [36]

3. Foreign policy, c.1793-1841

- (a) Explain why war broke out between Britain and France in 1793. [24]
- (b) To what extent was the Vienna Settlement the most significant achievement of British foreign policy, 1793-1841? [36]
